We are well underway with administering annual flu vaccinations. Don't forget you are eligible for a flu vaccination if you are:

- Aged 65 and over
- Have a long-term condition e.g., Asthma, COPD, Diabetes
- Pregnant
- A registered carer

If you have a child aged 4 years or under who has a history of significant respiratory illness, or any child under 18 in a clinical risk group, they can have a nasal flu vaccination.

It is not always a doctor who can help; Urgent Care Practitioners (for same day acute problems), a Mental Health Practitioner, Musculoskeletal Practitioners and Clinical Pharmacists are just some examples of alternative care that will speed up your treatment.
