# **Patient Navigators (Receptionists)**

Our receptionists have all been trained to be patient navigators. They need to signpost you to the most appropriate person for your needs. If you are asked the reason for an appointment request, please tell them; even if it is of a sensitive nature, a brief outline is required and will be treated in total confidence. It is not always a doctor who can help; Urgent Care Practitioners (for same day acute problems), a Mental Health Practitioner, Musculoskeletal Practitioners and Clinical Pharmacists are just some examples of alternative care that will speed up your treatment.
